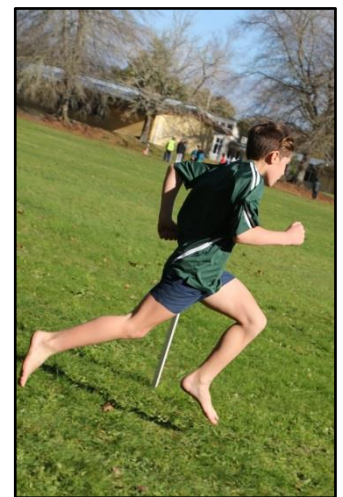
The string games were very popular, Percaeus shows us just how it is done.
