### Emergency Procedures

#### Earthquake

- 1 Drop.
- 2 Cover
- 3 Hold
- 4 When safe move to the field

#### Fire – sirens or continuous bell

1. **WALK** with your teacher to the field and line up in class lines.
2. Teachers will call the roll.
3. Stay in your class lines until you are told it is safe.

#### Lockdown – 4 bells or intercom message

1. Tell students we are in "LOCKDOWN"
2. Remain inside or out of sight until you are told you are safe
3. Stay in lockdown until you get the all clear by the office or police etc.
